

WISCONSIN VOTER INFORMATION



WHO NEEDS TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

If you have changed addresses or changed names since the last time you voted, you **MUST** re-register with the City of Verona. If you are a **NEW** Wisconsin Voter (you have never voted in Wisconsin before), you must register with the City of Verona. The state of Wisconsin has a residency requirement of 28 days prior to the election.

HOW DO I REGISTER ONLINE?

You can register to vote online at [MyVote Wisconsin](#) if you have a valid, unexpired Wisconsin Driver License or Wisconsin ID, and the address on file with Wisconsin DMV matches the address or your residence. If your address on file with the DMV is not current, please visit the [DMV Website](#) to update your address before registering to vote.

HOW DO I REGISTER BY MAIL?

You can download and complete a [Registration Application](#) and send the completed form along with proof of residence to:

HOW DO I REGISTER IN PERSON?

You can register to vote at Verona City Hall, 111 Lincoln St., Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. **Please note, you cannot register to vote the day before an election.**

CAN I REGISTER AT THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY?

You may register at the polls on Election Day if you choose to. Please bring a WI Drivers License (if you have been issued one and it is valid) and a proof of residence with you to the polls. Acceptable proof of residence documents include: valid WI Driver's License, utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, real estate bill, residential lease document, or any other government-issued document including the voter's name and address

If you choose to register on Election Day, please be prepared to spend a little more time at the polls.
